- Art. 4th To see if the town will take any measures to settle with John W. Rice for damages sustained in consequence of a defect in the highway near the house of Isaac Noyes.
- Art. 5th To see if the town will authorize the School Committee to purchase a copy of Worcester's Dictionary for each of the five school districts in town provided they can be had for two dollars per copy.
- Art. 6th To see if the town will accept of a Road laid out by the Selectmen on petition of Amory Maynard and others.
- Art. 7th To see if the town will discontinue the Road crossing at the foot of the Hill near Solomon Duttons Mill Pond to the Road leading from said mill to the Worcester Road.
- Art. 8th To see if the town will cover the Bridge near Solomon Duttons with Stone.
- Art. 9th To see if the town will allow John Hunt (in addition to his Highway tax) to keep in repair so much of the Highway as lies between the cross wall at the North East corner of his farm, and the Guide post near the house of Wm Hunt.
- Art. 10th To see if the town will discontinue the Old Road lying southerly of the New Road recently laid out by the Selectmen near the house of Daniel Smith.
- Art. 11th To see if the town will grant the free use of the Town Hall for Lyceum purposes the coming winter.
- Art. 12th To Hear and act on all Reports.
- Art. 13th To see if the town will grant the free use of the Town Hall for a Singing School the coming winter.
- Art. 14th To see the town will discount certain Taxes that may be offered for that purpose.
- Art. 15th To see if the town will give the free use of the Town Hall for Military purposes the coming winter.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the Town house and each of the public meetinghouses in said town two Sabbaths at least, before the time set for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this Warrant with your
