The Articles in the preceding Warrant were then taken up and acted upon as follows viz.

Art 1st Chose Capt. James Moore Moderator.

Art 2^d Voted to discontinue the Road referred to in this article

Art 3^d Voted to instruct the Selectmen to borrow the money (if necessary) to pay the Soldiers.

Art 4th Voted to instruct the Selectmen to examine the Road referred to in this article and confer with Mr Rice in reference to amount of damage and Report at the next meeting

Art 5th Voted to instruct the school committee to purchase copies of Worcester's Dictionary

Art 6th Voted not to accept of the Road laid out by the Selectmen on petition of Amory Maynard and others.

Art 7th Voted to Pass over.

Art. 8th Voted to instruct the Highway Surveyor to repair said Bridge by highway work if possible (with wood) if not to bring in a bill for the same to the Selectmen

Art 9th Voted to give John Hunt liberty to keep in repair the piece of highway mentioned in this article free from expence to the town.

Art. 10th Voted to discontinue as piece of Road near the House of Daniel Smith.

Art. 11th Voted to act on the 11th 13th & 15th at the same time, then voted to give the 13th & 15th free use of the Town Hall for Lyceum, Singing school, and Military purposes.

Art 12th Report concerning Repairs on Shermans Bridge and other Bridges accepted. Voted that the Selectmen draw an order for the balance.

Report in reference to erecting certain Grave Stones was accepted

Voted to instruct the Selectmen to agree with Sexton to carry the same into effect.

Report concerning Road near the house of Tho^s L Dakin accepted.
