

November 1850.

Tuesday November the twelfth 1850. the town met according to the aforesaid adjournment and gave in their votes for a Representative to the General Court as follows viz

1st Balloting

For Enoch Kidder forty six
Moses C. Hurbut forty five
Eli Willis thirty
Scattering eight and no. choice

2^d Balloting.

Whole no. one hundred thirty six
For Enoch Kidder fifty five
Moses C. Hurbut fifty one
Eli Willis twenty six
Scattering four and no. choice

3^d Balloting

Whole no. one hundred thirty seven
For Enoch Kidder fifty seven
Moses C. Hurbut fifty three
Eli Willis twenty three
Scattering four and no. choice

4th Balloting

Whole no. one hundred twenty eight
For Enoch Kidder fifty one
Moses C. Hurbut fifty nine
Eli Willis sixteen
Scattering two and no. choice

5th Balloting

Whole no. one hundred thirty three
For Moses C. Hurbut sixty one
Enoch Kidder fifty three
Eli Willis thirteen
Scattering six

6th Balloting

Whole no. one hundred twenty eight
For Moses C. Hurbut sixty three
Enoch Kidder forty eight
Eli Willis fourteen
Scattering three and no. choice

Then voted to instruct the Selectmen to call a Meeting for the choice of a Representative to the General Court on the twenty fifth inst. and that this Meeting be dissolved.
