In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts You are required to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury Qualified to Vote for Representatives in the General Court of this Commonwealth to meet at the Town Hall in said town on Monday the twentyfifth day of November current at half past eleven of the clock in the forenoon precisely to bring in to the Selectmen their votes for a Representative to Represent said town in the General Court of this Commonwealth to be convened on the first Wednesday of January next.

Polls to be opened at twelve O'Clock M. precisely and kept open two hours.

And you are furthermore required to notify the Inhabitants of said Sudbury Qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the above named time and place then and there to act on the following articles viz.

Art. 1st To choose a Moderator

Art. 2^d To see if the Town will accept of a Road located by the Selectmen on petition of Symon Howe and others.

Art. 3^d To hear and act on all Reports.

Art. 4th To see if the Town will receive the vote passed at the last meeting whereby they granted the free use of the Town Hall for Lyceums, Singing Schools, and Military purposes or grant the free use of said Hall for all other purposes which the Inhabitants of said Town may think proper, to do or act as the town may think best.

Art 5th To see if the Town will receive the vote passed at the last meeting whereby they discontinued the old Road near Daniel Smiths to do or act as the town may think best.

Art. 6th To see if the Town will order any thing further done to the Road and Bridge near Moores Mill to do or act as the town may think best.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the Town Hallse and each of the public meeting houses in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time sett for holding said meeting.
