And you are furthermore required to notify the Inhabitants of said Sudbury Qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the above named time and place then and there to act on the following articles viz.

Art. 1st To choose a Moderator

Art. 2^d To see if the Town will give the Assessors further instructions in reference to printing the Valuation for the use of the Inhabitants to do or act as the town may think best.

Art. 3^d To see if the Town will order Stone monuments placed at the angles of the Road near Mine way Brook, to do or act as the town may think best.

Art. 4th To see if the Town will pay to Asahel Balcom the sum of one per. cent for collecting the Taxes for 1849. to do or act as the town may think best.

Art. 5th To hear and act on all Report.

Art. 6th To see if the Town will procure Stone Guide Posts where new ones may be wanted, to do or act as the town may think best.

Said you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the Town house and each of the public meeting houses in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time set for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this Warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves at or before the time of Meeting as aforesaid.
