Art. 3^d To bring in their votes for a Register of Deeds for the County of Middlesex.

Art. 4th To Choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.

Art. 5th To determine the manner of Repairing Highways Town ways & Bridges the year ensuing and Grant Money for the same to do or act in reference to the repair of highways as the town may think best.

Art. 6th To hear and act on all Reports.

Art. 7th To see if the Town will give the Committee chosen to defend the suit brought against said town by John W. Rice any further instructions in reference to said suit to do or act in any way on said subject as the Town may think best.

Art. 8th To see what measures the Town will take to distribute the printed copies of the Revaluation of said Town to do or act as the town may think best.

And You are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the Townhouse and each of the public meeting houses in said town two sabbaths at least before the time set for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the town Clerk at or before the time of meeting as aforesaid.
