School Committee Report

Report of the Committee on accounts, then voted to Grant the sum of two hundred and twelve dollars & seventy-nine cents to pay said accounts.

Art. 7.th Voted to Grant for the Support of the Poor four hundred dollars.

For Winter Schools four hundred & fifty dollars

Voted to appropriate the sum of two hundred & fifty dollars now in the Treasury for the Summer Schools the present year.

Voted to Grant for Fuel for the Winter Schools eighty dollars.

For School House debt Eleven hundred & twenty dollars.

" Incidental Expenses three hundred dollars.

" Interest on the Joshua Stone Fund Sixty dollars.

" to pay the Treasurer ten dollars.

" Deficiency on last Year Grants four hundred dollars.

Art. 8.th Voted to let out the collecting to the lowest ^{biddn.} Elisha W. Haynes being the lowest bidder agrees to collect the Taxes for one per cent. It was then voted that the Taxes be paid in three Installments same as last year.

Art. 9.th Voted that all Town officers and all Committees while doing business for the town to have the free use of the Hall to be Lighted and Warmed at the Expense of the Town all other Inhabitants of the town to have the use of the Hall by paying the Expense of Lighting Warming & taking care of the House the time they occupy it. The use of the Hall may be granted to Individuals not belonging to town for all such Lectures & Exhibitions as the Selectmen shall think proper by paying such a sum as the Selectmen may agree upon. The Rifle company to have the free use of the Room under the Hall as occasion may require. And that the Selectmen shall not allow the Hall to be kept open after twelve O'clock at night.
