And also to act on the following articles viz.

- Art. 1st To Choose a Moderator.
- Art. 2^d To see if the town will take any further action in reference to a claim made by George W. Stone for damages sustained in consequence of an alledged defect in the Highway to do or act as the town may think best.
- Art. 3^d To see what action the town will take in reference to certain Taxes that the collector of 1850. refused to pay the Treasurer to do or act in any way respecting said Taxes as the town may Judge best.
- Art. 4th To see what measures the town will take in reference to a nuisance placed in the Highway near Wash Bridge to do or act in any way respecting said nuisance as the town may think proper.
- Art. 5th To see if the town will give the Selectmen any Instructions in reference to providing a suitable place to keep the Town Records and other valuable Documents belonging to said town, agreeable to a Law passed by the Legislature of 1851. to do or act as the town shall think best.
- Art. 6th To see if the town will take any measures to rebuild the Monument over the remains of Capt. Wadsworth and the men that were killed by the Indians near Green Hill in said town to do or act on said subject as they shall think proper.
- Art. 7th To see if the town will order their Poor House painted.
- Art. 8th To discount any Taxes that may be offered for that purpose.
- Art. 9th To see if the town will new district the town and build one or more New Schoolhouses to do or act in reference to new districting or building New Schoolhouses as they may think best.
- Art. 10th To see if the town will give to the Inhabitants the free use of the Town Hall until the first day of April next to do or act in reference to said subject as the town shall Judge best.
