Voted to choose a Committee of five one in each School district to superintend the building of said Monument, on the part of the town. with power to fill vacancies.

Chose Nahum Thompson, Darius Fairbank, Ephraim Moore, Enoch Kidder, and Jona. R. Vose, said Committee. Voted to adopt the plan sent from the States Prison should it meet the View of his Excellency the Governor.
