The articles in the preceding Warrant were then taken up and acted upon as follows viz.

Art. 1st Chose Capt. James Moore Moderator

Art. 2^d Voted to celebrate the completion of the Wadsworth Monument by an address and other appropriate exercises.

Voted that the building ~~Committee~~ on addition of five one in each school district be a committee of arrangements chose Lyman Howe John P. Allen Asahel Balcorri and Ephraim Stone It was then voted that said Committee be directed to fill the vacancy in the N. E. school district or any other that may occur.

Voted to instruct said committee to agree with some person to provide dinner for five hundred. That they present free Tickets to the Governor and Council and Members of the Legislature who may be present and likewise all other individuals which the committee may invite to take part in the celebration.

Voted to invite the Sudbury Brass Band to furnish Music on the occasion. - also Voted that the Sudbury Rifle Company be invited to do escort duty on the day of the celebration and that the committee be instructed to invite such other Military Companies as they shall think proper.

It was then Voted that meeting for town business be adjourned to Monday next at 10 O'clock A. M.

Monday Nov. 8th 1852. Met agreeable to the foregoing adjournment and under the 2^d Art. Voted to instruct the Committee of arrangements that if they cannot agree with the Sudbury Brass Band to furnish Music on the day of the celebration that they employ another Band for that purpose

Art. 3^d Voted to accept of the Report of the Committee chosen to Repair Shermans Bridge

Voted to dissolve the meeting
