Art. 2^d To see if the town will build a school house for the Centrl School District or provide a suitable place for said school, to do or act in reference to a schoolhouse for said district as the town shall Judge best.

Art. 3^d To see if the town will give the Sudbury Brass Band the free use of the Town Hall for a Music School to do or act in reference to said subject as the town may think best.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up an attested Copy thereof at the town house and each of the public Meetinghouses in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time set for holding said meeting.

Hereof I will not and make return of this Warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves at or before the time of meeting as aforesaid.
