Art. 9th To see if the town will take any measures to purchase a School house lot for the school house in the Centre District to do or act in reference to said school house lot as the town may think best.

Art 10th To see if the town will accept of a private Way laid out by the Selectmen on petition of Benjamin Smith and others

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up an attested Copy thereof at the Town house and each of the public Meetinghouses in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time set for holding said meeting

Hereof fail not and make return of this Warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves at or before the time of Meeting as aforesaid.
