For which balance the town are respectfully requested to make an appropriation.

The Committee would further report that they have come to an agreement with Mr. Israel H. Brown (subject to the approval of the town) to have the Monument lot made square with the new Road laid out to the same as follows; Beginning at the North easterly terminus of the new road and running Northerly at a right angle with the Northerly boundary of said New road one rod: thence turning at a right angle and running easterly ten rods thence turning at a right angle and running southerly four rods thence turning at a right angle & running westerly ten rods thence turning at a right angle and running Northerly three rods to the bounds first mentioned.

Mr. Brown offers to Quit Claim all within the aforesaid lines leaving to the Monument the same Quantity of Land as now & in a better form; The town are respectfully requested to authorize some person to make and pass said Deeds and receive one from Mr. Brown which must be at the expense of the town.
