- Art. 11th To see if the Town will accept of a Road laid out by the Selectmen on petition of Nathaniel Wade and Aaron S. Thompson.
- Art. 12 To see if the Town will discontinue a piece of Town Road on petition of Aaron S. Thompson.
- Art. 13th To see if the Town will allow to certain inhabitants of Ascutt the amount of their school Tax the present year to do or act as the town shall think proper.
- Art. 14th To see for what purposes and on what conditions the Town will allow the Town Hall to be used the ensuing year to do or act as the town shall Judge best.
- Art. 15th To see if the Town will purchase a suitable lot of Land on which to set the Centre School house to do or act as the town may Judge best.
- Art. 16th To see if the Town will offer a Bounty for the destruction of Crows to do or act as the Town may think best.
- Art. 17th To see if the Town will provide a Workhouse for the confinement of Vagabonds. Idlus &c to pass any Vote or Votes as the town shall think best.
- Art. 18th To see the Town will take any measures to transplant ornamental and Shade Trees around the Schoolhouses to pass any Vote or Votes as the Town shall think best.

And You are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the Town house and each of the public meetinghouses in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time set for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this Warrant with your doing thereon to ourselves at or before the time of Meeting as aforesaid.
