At a Legal meeting of the Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury held on Monday the fourth day of April A.D. 1853. the articles in the preceding Warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows.

Art 1st Gave in their votes for three County Commissioners on one ballot for the County of Middlesex also their votes on one ballot for two Special County Commissioners for said County all which while said meeting was yet open were sorted and counted and Public declaration there of was made in said meeting by the Selectmen and the same was as follows viz.

For three County Commissioners.

Whole number of Ballots one hundred ten
 Leonard Huntress of Jewellsbury had eighty votes
 Llewellyn P. Davis of Woburn had eighty one votes
 John H. Going of Shirley had eighty votes
 Daniel S. Richardson of Lowell had twenty eight votes

 Samuel Adams of Townsend had twenty three votes

For two Special County Commissioners.

Whole number of Ballots one hundred nine
 Paul H. Sweetser of South Reading had eighty one votes
 John Fletcher of Acton had seventy two votes.
 William Hastings of Frammingham had twenty seven votes
 Samuel Chandler of Lexington had twenty eight votes
