Art. 5th Voted to Grant the following sums viz.

For Support of the Poor four hundred dollars

" Schools eight hundred dollars

" Fuel eighty dollars

Voted to appropriate the sum of \$250 (out of the amt. granted for schools) for Summer Schools to be equally divided to the five districts and fifty dollars for the inhabitants of Assabet the remainder for Winter Schools

For Incidental Expences six hundred dollars

" Interest on the Trussha Howe Fund sixty dollars

" to pay the Treasurer ten dollars

" the Location of the Centre School House two hundred dollars

" to pay Accounts one hundred seventy six dollars 400

" " " Town debt & Interest twelve hundred dollars

Voted to Grant in addition to the Poor grant twenty five dollars to purchase a Wagon.

It was then Voted to take up the 13th art. Voted to reconsider the Vote whereby the town Voted to allow certain inhabitants of Assabet the amt. of their School Tax. Then Voted to allow said Inhabitants the sum of fifty dollars for the ensuing year

Art. 6th Voted that the Selectmen agree with some suitable person to collect the Taxes the ensuing year on the best possible terms for the interest of the town

Art. 7th Voted to instruct the Selectmen to print the Receipts and expenditures of the town the present year

Art. 8th Voted to discount to Asahel Balcom collector the following Taxes viz. John Dolans Tax \$1.50 Sherman Boghans \$1.50
Freeman Smiths \$1.50 Hollis Balcoms \$1.60

Art 9th Voted to instruct the assessors to take the Valuation of personal property the present year.

Art. 10th Voted to pass over.

Art. 11th Voted to accept of a Road laid out by the Selectmen on petition of N. Wade & A. S. Thompson.

Art. 12th Voted to discontinue use of highway referred to in agreeable to the report of the Selectmen.
