Art. 7th To see if the town will direct the time of payment of Taxes the ensuing year

Art. 8th To fill all vacancies that may occur in town offices by reason of non acceptance

Art. 9th To see if the town will give the Selectmen further instructions in reference to finishing the Room under the town hall.
