Art. 3^d To see if the town will recind the Vote whereby the town voted to Grant \$1200. to pay Town debt & interest to do or act as the town may think best

Art. 4th To see if the town will Choose a Committee to prepare the Spot for the Centre school house and remove the same.

Art. 5th To hear and act on all Reports.

Art. 6th To see if the town will procure Stone for the Causeway near Shirmans Bridge to do or act as they shall think best

Art. 7th To see if the town will choose a committee to procure subscriptions in aid of the Washington Monument.

Art. 8th To see if the town will allow a bill presented by Mr. Isaac Clark for repairs on the Centre School house.

Art. 9th To hear and act on the Report of the Selectmen in reference to a piece of land for the Centre school house to do or act in reference to a school house lot for said district as the town may Judge best.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up an attested Copy thereof at the Townhouse and each of the public meeting houses in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time set for holding said meeting

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the town Clerk at or before the time of meeting as aforesaid.
