

May. 1853.

At a Legal meeting of the Inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday the Sixteenth day of May A.D. 1853. the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows viz.

Art. 1st Chose Thomas B. Battles Moderator

Art. 2^d Voted that Treasurer be authorised to receive and receipt for the Legacy left by said Will & that the Treasurer together with the Selectmen be instructed to invest said sum in the best manner for the interest of the town

Art. 3^d Voted to pass over

Art. 4 Chose Abel B. Jones, Loring Wheeler, & Scander Haynes a Committee to prepare the spot & remove the Centre School house.

Art. 5th Voted to pass over.

Art. 6th Voted that the subject be left with the Highway Surveyor

Art. 7 Voted to Choose a Committee of five one in each School district to procure subscriptions in aid of the Washington Monument. Chose Capt Wm Brigham Thos B. Battles Ephraim Moore Aaron S. Thompson & Nahum Thompson said Committee.

Art. 8th Voted that the Selectmen be instructed to investigate the subject of this article & to settle said bill if in their opinion it is Just.

Art. 9th Voted to instruct the Selectmen to purchase, locate, or hire, a piece of Land for the Centre School house either on land of E. W. Haynes south of the Methodist Meetinghouse, or on land of the First parish West, of their Meetinghouse or on land belonging to the Methodist Society.

It was then Voted that the Meeting be dissolved
