In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts You are
required to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury Qualified
to Vote in town affairs to meet at the town hall in said town on Tuesday
the fifth day of July next at four of the Clock in the afternoon precisely
then and there to act on the following articles viz.

Art 1st To Choose a Moderator

Art 2^d To see if the town will choose a Committee to oppose before the
County Commissioners the location of a Road as petitioned for by
Saron S. Thompson & others.

Art. 3^d To see if the town will choose a Committee to meet the County
Commissioners at their meeting on petition of the Selectmen &
others to do or act as the town may think best.

Art. 4th To see if the town will give Charles Parmenter further instru-
ctions in reference to repairing the causeway near Shermans
Bridge to do or act as the town may Judge best.

Art. 5th To see if the town will give their Selectmen further instructions
in relation to a Lot or Lots for a Schoolhouse in the Centre
district of said town and to act any way thereon the town may
think best when met.

And You are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up an
attested Copy thereof at the town house and each of the public meeting
houses in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time set for holding
said meeting

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings
thereon to the town Clerk at or before the time of meeting as aforesaid.
