At a Legal town meeting held at Sedbury on Tuesday the fifth day of July A.D. 1853. the articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows viz.

Art. 1st Chose Thomas B. Ballles Moderator

Art. 2^d Voted to choose a committee of three to meet the County Commissioners at their meeting on petition of Aaron S. Thompson & others then Voted that the Selectmen be that Committee that they be instructed to oppose the location of said Road.

Art. 3^d Voted to choose a committee to meet the Commissioners it was then Voted that the Selectmen be a committee to meet the County Commissioners at their meeting on petition of Abel B. Jones & others & request the Commissioners to locate said road. — Also Voted that it be left discretionary with said committee to make such propositions to the Commissioners as they shall think proper, in regard to the expence of said road.

Art. 4th Voted that the Selectmen be instructed to give Charles Parmenter such directions as they shall think proper, in reference to the repairs as the causeway near Shermans Bridge.

Art. 5th Voted to pass over.
