Polls to be opened at half past nine O'Clock A.M.

And you are also required to notify the Inhabitants of said town Qualified to vote in Town affairs to meet at the above named time and place then and there to act on the following articles Viz.

Art. 1st To Choose a Moderator.

Art. 2^d To see if the Town will accept of a Road laid out by the Selectmen on petition of Paul Walker and others to do or act as the town shall Judge best.

Art. 3^d To see if the Town will discontinue a piece of Town Road on petition of Paul Walker.

Art. 4th To see if the town will Choose a Committee to make a distribution of the Interest that has arisen on the Elisha Goodnow Fund. to do or act as the town may think best.

Art. 5th To hear and act on all Reports that may be offered and pass any Votes relative to the same that the town shall think proper.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the Town House and each of the Public Meetinghouses in said town two Sabbaths at least before the time set for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this Warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves at or before the time of Meeting as aforesaid.
