It was then Voted to appropriate the sum of seventy six dollars out of any unappropriated Money in the Treasury to pay the Expense of the same. also to pay the expense of finishing the Room under the Town Hall, which Report was accepted.

Voted to accept of a Verbal Report in reference to laying out a Road across the common.

under this article it was Voted that the Selectmen be a Committee to cause the Road to be made across the common over land of the first Parish as the same may be laid out by the County Commissioners.

It was then Voted to dissolve the Meeting.
