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4. Voted to grant the sum of eight hundred dollars to repair Highways, Townways and Bridges the year ensuing, that six hundred dollars be divided by the assessors among the several Surveyors according to the length and condition of the Roads in their wards that the remainder be expended by order of the Selectmen as it shall be needed during the year

6. Voted to accept of certain books presented to the town by Mr. Plympton and that they be disposed of agreeable to his request, and that the town return a Vote of thanks for the same. Voted to request Rev. Mr. Shaw to communicate the action of the town in reference to the subject to Mr. Plympton.
7. Voted that the School Committee be instructed to investigate the subject referred to in this article and report at April meeting.

Voted that the remaining articles in this warrant be put over to April meeting
