To Samuel A. Jones Constable of the Town of
Sudbury in said County. Greeting.

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts You are required to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury Qualified to Vote in town affairs to meet at the Town Hall in said town on Monday the third day of April next at ten of the clock in the forenoon precisely then and there to act on the following articles viz.

1. To Choose a Moderator
2. To fill all Vacancies that may occur in town offices by reason of non-acceptance or resignation.
3. To hear and act on all reports and pass any votes relative to the same that the town may judge best.
4. To Grant money for all necessary purposes for the year ensuing.
5. To determine the manner of Collecting the Taxes that may be assessed upon the inhabitants of said town the present year and agree with some suitable person to collect the same
6. To see for what purposes and on what conditions the town will allow the Town Hall to be used the ensuing year to do or act as the town shall think best.
7. To act on the 8th and 9th articles in the Warrant for March meeting.
8. To see the town will rescind the vote passed at the last meeting whereby they agreed to levy a money Tax for the support of Highways for the year ensuing to do or act on the subject of Highways and appropriating Money for the same as the town shall think best.
9. To see if the town will discount certain Taxes that may be offered for that purpose.
10. To see the town will order the Receipts and Expenditures printed for the year ensuing.
11. To see if the town will instruct the Assessors to take the Valuation of Personal property the present year.
12. To see if the town will accept of a Road laid out by the Selectmen on petition of Wheeler Moore to do or act as they shall think best.
13. To see if the town will choose a Committee to make the appropriation of the interest arising from the Elisha Goodnow fund.
14. To see if the town will allow to Amory Maynard and others of Asabet Village at their request the amount of their School Tax for the present year to do or act as the town shall think best.
