16. To see if the town will take any measures to alter the mode of Ringing the Bell at Funerals to do or act as the town shall think best.
17. To see if the town will direct that the Horse now used on the Poor Farm be sold to do or act as the town shall judge best.

And You are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the town house and each of the public meeting houses in said town two sabbaths at least before the time set for holding said meeting

Hereof fail not and make return of this Warrant with your doings thereon to the town clerk at or before the time of meeting as aforesaid.
