To Samuel A. Jones Constable of the town of
Sudbury in said County. Greeting,

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts You are required to notify the inhabitants of the town of Sudbury Qualified to vote in town affairs to meet at the Town Hall in said town on Monday the twenty eighth day of August current at two of the Clock in the afternoon precisely then and there to act on the following articles viz.

1. To choose a Moderator
2. To see if the town will choose a Committee and authorize them to let out the making of the Road and Bridge ordered by the County Commissioners at the Assabet Village to Amory Maynard & Aaron S. Thompson agreeable to a proposition made by them to the County Commissioners, or to let out the making of the same to some other person or persons to do or act in reference to the subject as the town shall think best.
3. To see if the town will accept of a Road laid out by the Selectmen on the petition of Wheeler Moore and others to do or act as the town shall think best.
4. To see if the town will discontinue certain portions of a Town Way lately laid out on petition of Wheeler Moore and others.
5. To see if the town will compensate Maranda Page for damages sustained by injury to his Horse caused by a defect in the Highway to do or act as the Town may judge best.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the Town house and each of the public meetinghouses in said town two sabbaths at least before the time set for holding said meeting

Hereof fail not and make return of this Warrant with your doings thereon to the town clerk at or before the time of meeting as aforesaid.
