At a legal meeting of the Inhabitants of the town of Sudbury held on Monday August the twenty eighth A.D. 1854, the articles in the preceding Warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows viz,

1. Chose Nelson Fairbanks Moderator.
 2. Voted to lay this art. upon the Table and take up the third article
 3. Voted to accept of said Road and ordered the same to be recorded.
 4. Voted to discontinue certain pieces of Town way agreeable to a Report of the Selectmen.
 5. Voted that the subject referred to in this article be left with the Selectmen to investigate, and that they have discretionary power.
- Voted to take from the Table the second article.

It was then voted that the meeting for further action on that article be adjourned to Monday Sept 4th at two O'Clock P.M. - and the meeting in reference to the other articles be dissolved.
