Voted that the Selectmen be instructed to offer a suitable Reward for the detection and conviction of any person or persons who may be guilty of damaging our Public buildings Guide Posts or boards or committing any other depredations upon Public or Private property in town and that they take such measures as shall bring the same to justice.
8. Voted to Pass over.
10. Voted that the Selectmen be a Committee to examine the Several Bridges in town and make repairs as shall be necessary and report at April meeting.
11. Voted to pass over so much of this article as relates to the School District Libraries - Voted to instruct the School Committee to put the Dictionaries presented to the town by Mr. Plympton into the Several Schools.
