5. Voted that the Taxes be collected in the same manner as last

Year & that the Collecting be let out to the lowest bidder

Elisha W. Haynes agrees to collect the Taxes for sixty four cents on the hundred dollars, who was duly Chosen Collector

Voted to take up the 20th Art.

20 Voted that the General School Committee hire the Teachers at the School at Assabet & have the General Superintendence of the same & Report so far as the grant of twenty five dollars made by the town is considered. Voted to take up the 6th Article

6th Voted that the Town Hall be opened free for a public Singing School & for Lyceums the ensuing Year. It was then Voted to lay this article on the Table and take up the 9th

9. Voted to accept of a list of Jurors as made out by the Selectmen

Voted to adjourn this Meeting to Monday the sixteenth inst. at nine of the clock in the forenoon.

Monday April 16th 1855. Town met agreeable to the foregoing adjournment & Voted to take up the 4th article

Voted to grant the sum of one hundred dollars to Repair or rebuild the Bridges near Henry Goodnows.
