8. Voted to instruct the Assessors to take the vacation of Personal Property the ensuing Year.
9. Voted to pass over.
10. Voted to pass over
11. Voted that the District School Libraries be collected & deposited in some suitable place in the centre of the town.
Voted that a Committee of three be chosen to collect said Libraries & procure a suitable place for the same.
Chose Nelson Fairbank Tho^s Stearns and Lyman Howe.
Voted that all Rules & Regulations in reference to said Libraries be revoked and that said Committee be instructed to frame a Code of By-laws to govern the same & also appoint a Librarian
13. Voted to pay the expense of taking care of the Armory.
14. Voted to authorize the Treasurer to borrow money for the purposes specified in this article on the best conditions possible.
16. Voted to instruct the Prudential School Committee to hire the Teachers
17. Voted that the Selectmen be said Committee.
18. Voted to pay Ruth Willis fifty dollars for services in taking care of her mother
19. Voted to raise the ground in front of the Centre School House - Chose the Selectmen a Committee for that purpose
21. Voted to Paint and Whitewash the inside of the Town Hall and that the Selectmen be a Committee to let out the same
22. Voted to Pass over.
6. Voted to take up the 6th Art. It was then voted to reconsider all votes passed at the last meeting in reference to the purposes for which the Town Hall shall be used the ensuing Year.
Then voted that the Hall for all Town purposes be free for all purposes for which the inhabitants of said town may want it by paying the expense of Warming Lighting and taking care of the same.
Voted to take up the 4th Art. and Voted to Grant thirty dollars for taking care of the Armory - To pay Ruth Willis fifty dollars for to pay for Wall around the Berry ing Ground three hundred dollars.
