Art: 4th: continued. Voted to accept the report of the Selectmen relating to the disposal of the interest of the "Elisha Goodnow Fund"
 Voted to accept the Report of the Selectmen relating to the "Donation Fund"
 Voted to accept the Report of the selectmen relating to "Jerusha Howe Fund"
 Voted to accept the Report of the Selectmen relating to bills paid to the Highway Surveyors for overwork, and bills paid the School committee.

Art: 5th Voted that the Assessors be instructed to apportion the road to the warden as herein proposed

Art: 6th Voted that the Selectmen be a committee, to select some suitable place for a burying ground, for the town and report at April meeting

Art: 7th Voted that a committee of five be appointed by the chair, to take this matter into consideration, examine the premises and report at April meeting; voted, also, that this Committee give notice to all persons interested, when and where they will meet for the purpose of examining and discussing the whole subject; and Drury Fairbanks Samuel Puffer, Abel B. Jones, Aaron S. Thompson and John H. Dakin were appointed

Art: 8th Voted to instruct the school committee for last year to investigate the subject of damage to Centre School house, as far as possible, and to prosecute and punish the offenders, if sufficient evidence be found.

Voted that the school Committee for the present year be instructed to attend to the matter proposed in the second part of this article and report at April meeting

Art 9th Voted that a committee of three be appointed by the chair, to take this matter into consideration and report at April meeting, and W^m Brigham Drury Fairbanks and Joseph Smith were appointed

Voted to dissolve the meeting.
