- Article 12 To see if the town will take any measures to ascertain the amount of damages done in and about the several school houses, to do or act as the town may think best
- ... 13 To see if the town will cause their warrants for town meetings to be printed
- ... 14 To see if the town will instruct the town Clerk to procure a safe & book case in which to keep the town Records and books belonging to the town, and order the same to be kept in the town house to do or act as the town thinks best
- ... 15 To see if the town will take any measures to prevent the unlawful sale of intoxicating liquors, to do or act as the town thinks best
- ... 16 To see if the town will repair & paint their school houses the present year to do or act as the town thinks best
- ... 17 To see if the town will construct back yards and privies at their school houses where they are needed
- ... 18 To see if the town will grant to the individuals who may support a private school near the Powder Mills the coming ^{school} year or ~~any~~ ^{some} part thereof, a sum of money to be appropriated for the benefit of said school
- ... 19 To see if the town will instruct the Assessors, to take the valuation of personal property the present year.
- ... 20 To see if the town will instruct the Select Men for the year ending March 1857 to publish the receipts and Expenditures of the town for said year, also to instruct the Select Men for the present year to publish the receipts and expenditures of the coming year
- ... 21 To see if the town will take any action in regard to their school district libraries to do or act as the town thinks best
- ... 22 To see if the town will pay a bounty on Crows the present year to do or act as the town may think best

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof at the town house and at each of the public meeting houses in said town, two sabbaths at least before the time appointed for holding said meeting.
