

The Articles in the preceding warrant were taken up and acted on as follows, viz:

Article 1<sup>st</sup> Chose Capt James Moore. Moderator

Article 2<sup>nd</sup> Voted to accept the report of the Committee on Assa bet School House, and Voted to authorize this committee to borrow three hundred dollars in addition to the sum of one thousand, granted by the town, if they find it necessary to defray the necessary expenses of building the school house &c  
Voted to accept the report of the committee chosen to superintend the rebuilding of the wall around the old burying ground

Article 3 Voted that the collector for this year, have all the power to collect taxes, as proposed in this Article

A statement was made at this meeting by the Chair that the town of Wayland wished to procure a copy of certain records of the town, and the town, Voted, to give the town of Wayland liberty to copy such of the records as they wished, at the house of the clerk, or to employ any person in town to do the same
