Art. 3^d To see if the Town will take any measures towards building an arched stone bridge where the canal bridge now stands, to do or act in reference to said Canal bridge as the Town may consider expedient

Art 4th To hear, and act, on any reports that may be presented.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof, at the Town House and at each of the public Meeting houses in said town, seven days at least before the time appointed for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not, and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon, to ourselves, at or before the time appointed of meeting as aforesaid.
