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Art 8 To see if the Town will order their warrants for Town meetings for the present year, to be printed and a copy of the same to be posted at Assabet

Art 9 To see if the Town will give their Overseers of the Poor any instructions in regard to the Joseph Garfield case to do or act in reference to said case as the town may think fit

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up an attested copy thereof, at the Town House and at each of the public meeting houses in said town, seven days at least before the time appointed for holding said Meeting.

Hereof fail not and make return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk on or before the time appointed for holding said meeting.
