Article 4 Voted to Grant the sum of twelve hundred and fifty dollars for the repair of Highways town ways & Bridges. and that it be expended in the same manner as last year

Article 5 Voted that the Assessors be directed to apportion the road as herein proposed

Article 6 Voted that a Committee of three be chosen to lay out the ground into lots, reserving at least one third. and that the lots be sold, and the proceeds of such sales go into the treasury. Voted, also, that the Selectmen be this Committee and that they be instructed to grade and improve the ground in such manner as they think proper.
