

- Art. 9. To see if the town will choose a committee to make the distribution of the interest arising from the "Elisha Goodnow fund"
- Art. 10. To see if the town will take any measure to dispose of a part or the whole of their Poor Fund. to do or act as the town may think proper
- Art. 11. To see if the town will request their board of Overseers of the Poor to make rules, regulations, and a code of by laws by which the Pauper establishment shall be governed and lay the same before the town at a subsequent meeting of the town for their approval. To do or act in any way in regard to all who want or need assistance from the town.
- Art. 12. To see if the town will lend any of their Books of Records to the town of Wayland. for the purpose of copying to do or act &c
- Art. 13. To see if the town will cause a book case to be made in which to keep the printed books belonging to the town and order the same to be kept in the town house. to do or act &c
- Art. 14. To see for what purposes and on what conditions the town will allow the town hall to be used the ensuing year and agree with some suitable person to take care of the same.
- Art. 15. To see if the town will take any measures to provide the several Highway wards with gravel. to do or act &c
- Art. 16. To see if the town will pay the expense of taking care of the Armory the present year
- Art. 17. To see if the town will take any measures to have their Town House and the several school houses painted the present year to do or act &c
- Art. 18. To see if the town will take any measures to divide and keep in repair the fence between their farm and land owned by Joel Parmenter to do or act &c.
