In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
you are hereby required to notify and warn the
inhabitants of said town of Sudbury qualified to
vote in town affairs to assemble at the town hall
in said town on Monday the second day of Aug-
ust next at five o'clock in the afternoon, pre-
cisely, then and there to act on the following
Subjects, viz:

Art 1st To Choose a Moderator to preside in said meeting

Art 2^d To see if the town will choose an agent or agents
to meet the County Commissioners on the petition
of Cyrus Hunt & others. to do or act &c.

Art 3^d To see if the town will empower their Overseers of
the Poor to give a deed of a certain portion of their
Poor Farm. to do or act &c

Art 4th To Hear and act on Reports.

And you are directed to serve this warrant.
by posting up an attested printed copy thereof
at the Town House, at each of the public meeting-
houses in said town and at J. A. Protty's store
in Assabet, two Sabbaths at least before the time
appointed for holding said meeting.

Hereof fail not
and make due return of this warrant, with your
doings thereon to the town Clerk at or before the time
for holding said meeting. Given under our hands this
twenty first day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred & fifty eight
