

Sudbury August 30th 1858

I have served the within warrant by posting up attested printed copies of the same at the Town House at each of the public meeting houses and at J. A. Prouty's store in Assabet two Sabbath's before the time of said meeting

Webster Moore, Constable.

At a Legal Town Meeting holden at the Town Hall in Sudbury on Monday the thirtieth day of August A.D. 1858, the Articles in the foregoing warrant were taken up and acted upon as follows. Viz.

Art 1st Chose Capt. James Moore. Moderator.

Art 2^d Voted to instruct the committee chosen by the Town August 2^d 1858, to oppose all the proposed straightenings and alterations (in the highway petitioned for by Cyrus Hunt & others.) north of the one near Newell Bents.

Art 3^d Voted to instruct the Select men to print the receipts and expenditures of the town for the present year

Art 4th The Committee chosen Aug 2^d 1858 to meet the County commissioners, in their view of certain straightenings & alterations in the road from Isaac Clark's to the N.E. School House, made a verbal report. - that they had recommended to the commissioners the ^{proposed} alterations near Thomas P. Kurlbut. - near Hunt & Gerry's Store. - near the Burying Ground, and near Newell Bents, and that they had neither recommended or opposed any others but had left them to the discretion of the County Commissioners
