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And you are also required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the said town of Sudbury qualified to vote in town affairs to assemble in the Town Hall in said town on Tuesday the second day of November next, at one of the clock in the afternoon there and there to act on the following Subjects Viz:

Art 1st To Choose a Moderator to preside in said Meeting

Art 2^d To see if the town will rebuild Leander's Bridge to do or act in reference to said Bridge as the town shall think proper

Art 3^d To hear and act on reports.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up ^{an} attested printed copy of the same at the Town House at each of the public Meeting Houses in said town and at J. A. Prouty's store in Assabet two sabbaths at least before the time appointed for holding said meeting.

Whereof fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doing therein to ourselves at or before the time of said meeting
