To Edwin A Gray, a Constable of the Town of Sudbury in said County. Greeting;

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury qualified as the constitution requires to vote in town affairs to assemble at the Town Hall in said Town, on Monday the fourth day of April next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon then & there to act on the following subjects, Viz:
