

- Art 4th To see if the Town will let the inhabitants of the Powder Mills Village have their school Tax the present year, to do or act as the town may think best:
- Art 5th To see if the Town will take any measures other than by the usual Highway Tax, to repair the Landham Road, so called, to do or act &c
- Art 6th To determine the manner of warning Town Meetings the ensuing year
- Art 7th To see if the Town will instruct the Selectmen to print the Receipts and Expenditures of the Town the present year
- Art 8th To see if the Town will instruct their Assessors to print a list of the Polls and Estates in the Town of Sudbury the present year, with their assessment on the same:
- Art 9th To see if the Town will cause boxes to be placed on the several Meeting Houses in town to post warrants in, with the consent of the several parishes
- Art 10th To see if the Town will cause a door to be constructed from each of the lobbies in the Town House into the Hall,
- Art 11th To see if the Town will take any measures to have their Town House and the several Schoolhouses painted the present year, to do or act &c.
- Art 12th To see if the Town will remunerate the School Committee of 1857 for money paid by them for the use of the Hall for the purpose of lectures by an agent of the Board of Education
- Art 13 To see if the Town will pay a Bounty on Crows the present year
- Art 14 To hear and act on Reports
- Art 15 To see if the Town will accept a list of furors made out by the Selectmen
