- Art 27 To see if the town will determine the number of days that shall constitute a week in the services of their school teachers the present year
- Art 28 To see if the town will pay the expense of taking care of the Armory the present year
- Art 29 To see if the town will take any measures to provide their several highway wards with gravel ^{where it is needed} ~~the present year~~
- Art 30 To see if the town will choose a committee to let out the making of certain pieces of highway located by the County Commissioners on petition of Cyrus Hunt & others
- Art 31 To see if the town will instruct their Assessors to add the tax of non-residents to their money tax, and order the collector to collect the same

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting up attested printed copies of the same at the Town House, at each of the public Meetinghouses in said town and at Isaac A Prouty's Store in Assabet, two sabbaths at least before the time appointed for holding said meeting.
