Whole amount of Grants excepting for Highways — \$ 3441.05

Voted that the above grant for schools be distributed equally in the several districts, with the same understanding in regard to the grant for Fuel as last year.

Art 4 Voted to give the amount of their School Tax to such of the inhabitants of the Powder Mills Village as send their children to school in the town of Acton

Art 5 Voted to Grant \$100. for the purpose ^{proposed} in this Article. Also Voted that the Chair appoint a committee of one person to superintend the laying out of the above grant, and the Chair appointed Capt W^m Brigham
