- Art 6 Voted. that the town meetings be warned in the same manner as last year
- Art 7 Voted to instruct the Selectmen to print the Receipts and Expenditures as usual.
- Art 8 Voted to instruct the Assessors to print a list of the Poles and Estates in the Town of Andover the present year with their assessment on the same
- Art 9 No Vote passed upon this Article
- Art 10 Voted to pass over this Article.
- Art 11 Voted to paint the five older School Houses the present year. Voted also, that the Chair appoint a committee of three to carry into effect the above vote, and the Chair appointed. Messrs Benj. W. Richardson, Abel B. Jones, and Samuel A. Jones. Then Voted to instruct the above committee to repair and put in order the said school Houses and blinds and put ~~in~~ two good coats of paint on each
- Art 12 Voted that the Selectmen be instructed to ^{pay} the School committee of 1857 certain money paid by the said committee for the use of the Hall for lectures by an agent of the Board of Education
- Art 13 Voted to Pass over this Article
- Art 14 The following Reports were read and Accepted.
 Viz: Report of School Committee
 Report of Selectmen on Guide Posts & Boards
 " " " on Town House
 " " " on Lignon Agency.
- The Selectmen made a report on the case of Patrick Lyons, and after some discussion the town finally Voted to pay said Lyons ten dollars if he would give a receipt in full for the loss of his horse, which he agreed to do, and the above named sum of money was paid him by the Selectmen; his receipt taken and the case settled. A Report was read by the Committee on Accounts when the Town Voted to strike out of said report a certain Bill of Isaac Clark against the town
