Art 17 Voted that the Selectmen be a committee to distribute the interest arising from the Elisha Goodnow Fund, excepting that part which is to be used for the purchase of books for poor children, which shall be distributed by the School Committee.

Art 18 Voted that the Taxes be collected in the same manner as last year and that the collecting of the same be let out to the lowest bidder, and Edwin A. Gerry agrees to collect all the taxes that may be assessed upon the inhabitants of the town for thirty nine dollars. Then the said Edwin A. Gerry was chosen Collector of Taxes by ballot.

Art 19 Voted that the Town House may be used for the same purposes and on the same conditions as last year, with this addition, that it shall be opened, warmed, and lighted, free for lectures by any agent of the Board of Education, then voted to let out the taking care of said house to the lowest bidder and it is taken by Edwin A. Gerry for \$45.
