- Art 25 Voted to instruct the Assessors to collect all the births of persons now living in ^{the} town ^{of Sudbury}, who were born in ^{said} town previous to the year 1844, also all marriages of persons now living in said town who were married in said town previous to said year, also all deaths which occurred in said town previous to said year, which shall be in their power to collect, in an accurate and reliable manner, that the same shall be returned to the Town Clerk for record. Voted also, that the Town Clerk be instructed to prepare and index of all the Births, Marriages and Deaths recorded in the record books of the Town, which are not already indexed
- Art 26 Voted to lay this Article on the table
- Art 27 Voted to leave this subject with the school committee
- Art 28 Voted to allow the same sum for this purpose as last year
- Art 29 Voted to leave this subject with the select men to act as they think for the interest of the Town
- Art 30 Voted that the ~~the~~ Selectmen be the committee proposed in this Article
- Art 30 Voted to pass over this Article.
