And you are directed to serve this warrant, by posting up an attested printed copy thereof at the Town House, at each of the Public Meeting-Houses in said town and at O. C. Wilbur Jr's Store in Assabet, two Sabbaths at least before the time appointed for holding said Meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon to ourselves at or before the time of meeting aforesaid
