Art 1 Chose Capt James Moore Moderator

Art 2 Voted to grant the sum of \$219.50 to make up the deficiency of the grant made at April meeting to pay for making the road located by the County Commissioners on petition of Cyrus Hunt & others.

Art 3 Voted to instruct the Selectmen to move the wall mentionned in this Article if it can be done Legally and without expense to the town, the above vote was as follows Yeas 32. Noes 7.

Art 4 The Overseers of the Poor made a verbal report concerning the situation of Georgianna Haynes an insane pauper now at the Hospital in Worcester and the town voted to instruct said Overseers to remove said Georgianna Haynes from said
